# *Night Will Find You*

## Reading Group Guide

Welcome to the Reading Group Guide for *Night Will Find You*. Please note: In order to provide reading groups with the most informed and thought-provoking questions possible, it is necessary to reveal important aspects of the plot of this novel—as well as the ending. If you have not finished reading *Night Will Find You*, we respectfully suggest that you consider waiting before reviewing this guide.

1. *Night Will Find You* tackles the mysteries of the universe—often the things we can't see but must accept on faith. What kind of role does faith play in your life whether it is belief in a higher power or a trust in science or both? Do you believe the two are a necessary combination or mutually exclusive in the infinite quest for truth?
2. Our world seems particularly rife with conspiracy theories. Are there conspiracy theories—like the JFK assassination, Marilyn Monroe's death, unexplained UFOs—engrained in our culture that you find legitimate? Do you believe the government ever lies to you? What is “the wildest” conspiracy theory you think has merit?
3. Have you personally had a “psychic” moment where you had *deja vu*, felt the presence of someone who had died, predicted something that actually happened?
4. How did you feel about the character Bubba Guns? What do you think of the extreme real-life conspiracy theorists he is based on, like Alex Jones, who spout hate and admit to lying about tragic things like Sandy Hook to provoke people? What role do they play in our culture?
4. What do you think about limiting freedom of speech when it comes to hate speech? How do feel about banning books in schools? If you limit one, do you have to limit the other?
5. Vivvy Bouchet is the heart of this book, and struggles to align all of her gifts. Did you feel like she was a realistic heroine—that her psychic gifts were portrayed in a way that was believable?
6. Have you ever been to a psychic or had your cards read? Did you think it was a scam or was there something that made you think twice? Do you believe there are legitimate psychics? Do you have anecdotal evidence?
6. Vivvy has a great divide with her sister over a significant issue. Have you ever had a childhood conflict with a sibling that was always there under the surface but never talked about? We all like happy endings, but do you believe any conflict can be overcome with family or is it sometimes better to let the relationship go?

7. Do you think it is possible, as Mike says, to be in love with two people at once but have to choose? Has that happened to you? Have you ever wondered, what if?

8. Sharp's and Vivvy's relationship is filled with sexual tension but they barely touch. Discuss!

9. Julia's cousin Sean Stapf, a rocket scientist, and his astrophysicist friend, Tom Ricketson, helped advise her on the book. What did you find to be the most interesting fact or theory?

10. Do you think the Blue Horse, once revealed, is a metaphor for how we look at things?
